Additionally, the GACC has substantial reserves that it can choose to spend and is planning to hold a meeting this week to discuss how that could be spent. I was thinking out aloud and posed the question.

If we have the money, is the cycle path the best idea? That point has been addressed above.

This is important because public expenditure is required to meet what is called the Value For Money test. FoGA do not spend the money we just confirm our support.


Adam Weekes made it clear he does not want it raised. That is a valid view, which I would certainly wish to hear more about.

Other than that:

- 1. A tennis court, I am asking Round Diamond about that (it is their commercial decisions)
- 2. Crime is on all the Councils agenda as is road safety, but there are limited resources and choices need to be made.
- 3. The woods are being well looked after and there is a discussion about extending the GA circular walk westwards. I think that would cost about £65k.

The other matters seem to be ok and in hand.

My understanding is that at the last GACC meeting, the issue of post Covid financial constraints was raised at the GACC were unconcerned. I am interested in that pot of money, which is what I thought you were asking George?
